

St. Andrew's Episcopal Church Presents Godspell

The parish and friends of St. Andrew's Episcopal Church located in Burt, NY will present Stephen Schwartz's *Godspell* on Friday, July 28th and Saturday, July 29 at 7pm and Sunday, July 30th at 2pm.

First produced on Broadway in 1971, *Godspell* broke new ground in its stage treatment of the historical Jesus Christ. Based on the Gospel according to St. Matthew it deals with the last days of Jesus, and includes dramatized versions of several well-known parables. The disciples discover what is really important and how to live each day together in harmony. The composer of *Godspell*, Stephen Schwartz, explains the story as "a group of disparate people slowly become a community built around one charismatic individual (Jesus), who then leaves them and they have to carry on as a community without him." Under the Direction of Melissa Naylor, Joe Breczka, and Doug Wintersteen, this entertaining production will share God's message to the larger community.

The show will run on Friday, July 28th and Saturday, July 29 at 7pm, and Sunday, July 30th at 2pm at St. Andrew's church in Burt, NY. The show is approximately 90 minutes long and is appropriate for all ages. Tickets are needed to attend and a \$5.00 minimum donation per ticket is recommended. Tickets will be available at the St. Andrew's Community Store and Shoppe on Main, both located in the town of Newfane. A limited number of tickets will be available at the door. Feel free to contact the church office to inquire about tickets.
