Altar Flowers – Having flowers at the altar is an act of praise and thanksgiving to a Living God. No matter how beautiful artificial flowers may be, they do not express this same faith in a God in whom we live and move and have our being. It is our custom for individuals or families to provide the flowers at the altar each Sunday. Please sign up on the Flower Chart in the narthex for any date during the year (except for Advent & Lent)—in thanksgiving, in memory of a loved one, or in observance of a special anniversary or occasion. The cost is \$35; checks should be payable to Pallister House, and given to Mike Depew by the Thursday before the date for which the flowers will be ordered. As an alternative, you could prepare two simple bouquets from your garden. If you would like to make this contribution, please sign up on the Flower Chart and write “garden” so that we will not order flowers.

SCRIP and TOPS cards – As you plan your summer projects at home and in your garden, or if you would like gift cards for graduations and weddings, please consider purchasing cards from Deacon Rocky. He will order the cards for you, and they will arrive within 2 weeks; at no cost to you, St. Andrew’s will earn a percentage of your purchase. Please consider planning your grocery budget by using TOPS cards that you purchase from Rocky each month; cards are available every Sunday, and Rocky can arrange to have cards available for you on a designated Sunday every month.
